Mass Save Revision To The ECM Pump Rebate

64 Towns in Massachusetts, and 3 in Rhode Island, are

NO LONGER ELIGIBLE

for the \$100 ECM Residential Pump Rebate.

This will also impact some commercial gas applications.

These towns have their own electric departments and do not pay into the program.

A list of towns no longer eligible for the rebate follows.
